



What to bring on sailing vessel “Praise The Lord”

“PTL” guests are encouraged to provide their own meals, drinks, towels and linens. Limited storage for dry goods, perishables and personal items is available. **We encourage guests to pack lightly with all personal items fitting into one back-pack sized carrier.**

“PTL” is designed as a home on the water with a fully equipped galley including: stove, microwave, propane grill, small (dorm size) refrigerator, coffee maker, sink and utensils. It also has two bathrooms with showers.

“PTL” trips may provide opportunities for fishing. Rods/reels and tackle is available for our guests. The vessel has a VA saltwater recreational boat fishing license which provides passengers the opportunity to fish without an individual license and while on-board.

The following are suggested items for a comfortable, enjoyable and safe trip:

Day Trip:

- ✓ Completed liability waiver covenant (anyone under 18 years old needs parental signature)
- ✓ Boating shoes, tennis shoes or closed toed sandals **(no bare feet, flip-flops or hard soled shoes)**
- ✓ Appropriate seasonal clothing (extreme and variable conditions can be expected on the water)
- ✓ Appropriate swimwear and towel
- ✓ Sunglasses
- ✓ Sunscreen
- ✓ Camera
- ✓ Binoculars
- ✓ Sea sickness medication
- ✓ Cooler(s) and plenty of ice
- ✓ Plenty of drinks
- ✓ Meals and snacks
- ✓ Bait (Fishbites brand of imitation bloodworms is recommended)
- ✓ **NO ALCOHOL OR TOBACCO USE ON-BOARD**

Overnight Trip:

- ✓ All items noted for a day trip
- ✓ Sleeping bag or comforter
- ✓ Pillow case (pillows are provided)
- ✓ Personal toiletries and towel
- ✓ Bug spray
